

HOW TO GET TO LA MANDORLA

From Barcelona :

1. Exit Barcelona by the Ronda Litoral or the Ronda de Dalt, direction Llobregat
2. Follow directions to Tarragona

You can either take the northern route via Vilafranca del Penedes, or the coastal route via Vilanova i la Geltru.

3. After the Tarragona toll booths, take the dual carriageway and exit at Reus E Aeroport.
4. Take the T11 (Reus ring road) and follow directions to Falset.

On leaving the T11, after a large bend and a petrol station on your left, turn right to Los Borges del Camp, Cornudella de Montsant.

5. Go through Les Borges and Alforja. Go through the Alforja pass and carry straight on until you see a white restaurant, "Venta d'en Puvill".

6. Follow signs to Cornudella de Montsant and continue for another 2 km.

You'll see a blue sign saying "Petrol station in 1 kilometre". 15 metres after the sign turn left onto a track just before the bend. You should see a stone wall and olive trees.

If you miss the turning you'll get to the village of Cornudella. Make a U-turn at the petrol station, but watch out for the track as there's no sign for the petrol station when you're coming back the other way.

7. Follow the main track for around 2 km until you get to an intersection in front of a cereal field. Don't turn right, follow the track round to the left and carry on downhill for around 1.5 km.

8. You should arrive at a parking sign and see a yurt on the hill to the left.

Please park here, below the field of almond trees, and walk the rest of the way to La Mandorla.
